

Installation guide for Lloyd's Lasers VST v0.2

Windows

Run the installer executable *Lloyds Lasers Win64 Setup.exe* and follow the instructions on the screen.

The default install directory is:

`C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3\Lloyd Stellar`

Open your DAW (Ableton, FL Studio, Cubase etc) and rescan for VST3 plugins.

Open Lloyds Lasers in your DAW.

Happy pew pew peeewing!

MacOS

1. Run the installer:

- Open the dmg file: `Lloyds Lasers MacOS.dmg`
- Double-click the `.pkg` file.
- A window may appear that says the file is from an unidentified developer (If not, go to step 5).

2. Open Security & Privacy Settings:

- Click on the Apple menu in the top left corner.
- Select **System Preferences**.
- Click on **Security & Privacy**.
- Go to the **General** tab.

3. Allow the Installer:

- You will see a message saying:
"Lloyds Lasers was blocked from opening because it is not from an identified developer."
- Click the **Open Anyway** button.

4. Run the Installer Again:

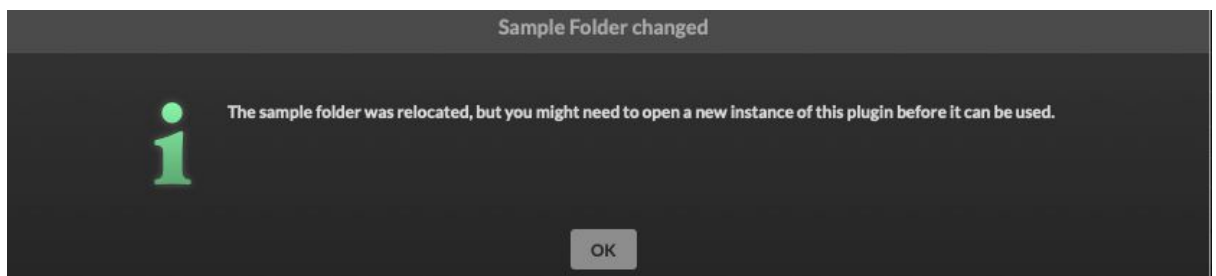
- Double-click the `.pkg` file again.
- A new warning window will appear.
- Click **Open** to start the installation.

5. Follow the instructions on the screen:

- The default install directory is, do **not** change this:
`/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/Lloyd Stellar`

6. Open your DAW (Ableton, FL Studio, Cubase etc):

- Rescan for VST3 plugins.
- Open the plugin Lloyds Lasers.
- When you open the plugin in your DAW, there is a change you need to select a writable working folder for the plugin. You can choose the default “Music” folder in `/Users/<yourusername>/Music/` for example. You should get a message like this after that:



- Close the plugin and start a new one.
- Happy pew pew peeeeewing!
